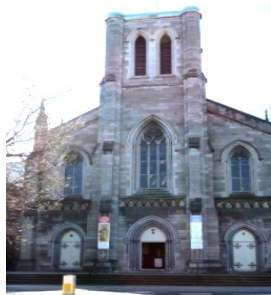

SAINT VINCENT De PAUL SOCIETY

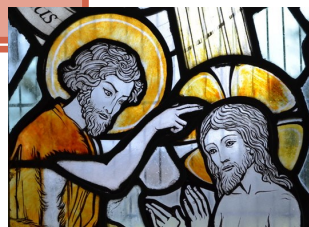
